


A study guide for
Alchemy – The Divine Work



The way we teach alchemy is to always combine *ora & labora*, study and practice. Thus, while it is possible to read our book from beginning to end, it is in reality written for a cyclic study and practice.

To clarify this, on the following pages are our suggestions for how to work the first philosophical year of four parts, going from the black nigredo to the red rubedo. (The second philosophical year deals with the three alchemical weddings and the operations, while the third year focuses on the alchemical stones or bodies.) Philosophical studies will enhance the practical work, and the practical work will deepen the philosophical understanding. Each part and alchemical phase should be infused in one's life so that both waking and sleeping patterns emerge and can be transformed in body, soul and spirit.

In any and all esoteric work, a regular study and practice cannot be overemphasised! While alchemy is a spiritual path in itself, it can also be seen as a meta system that easily integrates with any other esoteric system. Therefore, you can combine your preexisting daily esoteric work with alchemical study and practice.

When you combine theoretical study with practical work, many of the hidden keys of the alchemical path will be unveiled and new doors or portals will be shown. These keys and portals can often be viewed in the illustrations that accompany the text and the practices, but they need to be unlocked by the alchemist through *ora & labora*.


